An optional online test leads to the professional certification. Alaska QPR Gatekeeper Suicide • This updated version of Alaska's Gatekeeper Suicide Prevention Curriculum is based on the QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer) National evidence-based model. It is a 1 day training. • This training assist youth in developing skills necessary to function as an adult . The key areas covered are: Preparation for Adult Living (PAL) Life Skills Health and Safty, Housing and Transportation, Job Readiness, Financial Management, Life Curriculum Decisions/Responsibility and Personal/Social Relationships.
